BCRG is a non-profit community managed organisation which has been dedicated to working with children and families for over 34 years.

We are seeking a motivated and experienced program facilitator to support and enhance the development and wellbeing of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children from 0-12 years and their families. The successful applicant will have skills and experience in building rapport and trust with local Aboriginal communities. The role includes planning and facilitating a weekly playgroup, two primary school cultural programs and a family connect to culture group, providing cultural experiences and activities and referral support to children and families that may need assistance. A strong sense of community connection is essential, along with good communication and support skills.

SALARY: PART TIME POSIITON, 3-month contract, 24 hours over 4 days per week, SCHCADS Award level 5, pay point 3, \$44.89 – level 6, pay point 2, \$47.95 based on experience + Leave loading and super, with the possibility of extension.

Essential Criteria

1. Experience working with children 0-12 years and their families
2. Ability to program and plan culturally appropriate activities and experiences for children 0-12 years, to build on children and family's sense of cultural identity
3. Ability to share cultural knowledge and experience
4. An understanding of the issues affecting Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people
5. An ability to communicate sensitively and effectively with Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people of all ages
6. Good verbal and written communication skills
7. Good computer skills e.g., Microsoft Word, email
8. Group facilitation and organisational skills
9. Current Working with Children and Federal Police Check Clearance
10. It is an essential requirement of the role that successful applicants will be fully vaccinated according to the NSW Health Department Guidelines
11. Current Driver's license and use of a comprehensively insured car for work purposes

Desirable Criteria

1. Aboriginality
2. Relevant Tertiary Qualifications in Community Development or Early Childhood or Primary Education
