As an Early Childhood Teacher and Educational Leader of the preschool, you can demonstrate sound pedagogical knowledge, exceptional written & oral communication skills and the ability to develop respectful relationships with children, families, the community and engage educators being a positive, inclusive leader.

### **Our Preschool**

BCRG is a non-profit, community-based organisation who have been providing supports to children and the community for over 34 years. BCRG Chester Hill Preschool was established in 2017, it has developed into a vibrant multicultural Preschool located on the grounds of Chester Hill Public School. We provide early education and care for children aged 3-5 years, Monday to Friday 8.30am - 4.00pm. The Preschool is closed during school holidays. We have 2 classrooms and 40 children per day. Our educators are committed to providing a high standard of education and care. We promote the safety, wellbeing, and inclusion of all children.

Our philosophy around programming and documentation is a focus on providing quality interactions and teaching moments. We promote visible and meaningful documentation of the children's thinking, learning and development.

There are opportunities for professional development and networking within a supportive management team.
