We invite applications for a Diploma Qualified Educator (41 weeks term time) to join our team in providing high quality early childhood education and care to children 3 to 6 years. The Preschool is a brand new 40 place centre located within the grounds of Chester Hill Public School. The position is to commence early 2017. You will be paid in accordance with the Children's Services Award 2010.

About the Role:

BCRG is seeking a motivated Diploma-trained Educator to join our team. As part of our team you will engage children in their learning; develop strong relationships with their families and contribute to our educational program that focuses on children's strengths and interests.

Additionally, you will work closely with the team towards continuous improvement in all aspects of the preschool's operations

This includes:

- Working as part of a team to implement best practice as per the Education and Care Services National Regulation and Law and the Early Years Learning Framework curriculum
- Develop positive relationships with children reflecting a child focused and strengths based approach;
- Develop positive relationships that support and value families;
- Develop relationships that support and partner with the school and the wider community.
- Ensure that BCRG policies and procedures are implemented and adhered to; and
